Intent

At Chaucer Infant and Nursery School we deliver a PSHE curriculum which fully supports our school values whilst developing a strong sense of self-confidence and self-esteem and increasing positive wellbeing and mental health. We encourage children to aim high, try their best, be curious about the world in which we live, be respectful and trustworthy, be caring and above all be happy.

A planned programme of learning is used to cover our PSHE curriculum and is delivered through circle times, stories, discussions, role play and debates. We use the PSHE Matters scheme to support our teaching of PSHE. The PSHE Matters scheme fully supports and incorporates our school values.

Throughout our PSHE curriculum our children are also taught a progressive curriculum of Relationships and Health Education. The Department for Education announced changes to relationships and sex education which were due to come into effect in September 2020 however, this was delayed until Summer 2021. Following these changes, all schools are required to comply with the updated requirements.
